NAME

CURLMOPT_CONTENT_LENGTH_PENALTY_SIZE – size threshold for pipelining penalty

DESCRIPTION

Pass a long with a **size** in bytes. If a pipelined connection is currently processing a request with a Content-Length larger than this *CURLMOPT_CONTENT_LENGTH_PENALTY_SIZE(3)*, that pipeline will then not be considered for additional requests, even if it is shorter than *CURLMOPT_MAX_PIPELINE_LENGTH(3)*.

DEFAULT

The default value is 0, which means that the size penalization is inactive.
